- Create and disseminate IAVM Notices to identify and address emerging vulnerabilities that impact DODIN systems.
- Create Situational Awareness Reports and other technical reports related to emerging vulnerabilities that impact DODIN systems.
- Determine and direct appropriate actions to mitigate/remediate vulnerabilities affecting DODIN systems.
- Communicate with vendors to ensure identified vulnerabilities within their products are addressed and DODIN systems are adequately protected.
- Provide technical and procedural recommendations for the development of IAVM program initiatives to identify and address emerging vulnerabilities and threats.
- Represent the USCC IAVM Team at conferences/meetings.
- Support tactical, operational, and strategic planning for Defense in Depth initiatives by gathering information, conducting analysis, developing a viable Course(s) of Action
- Provide technical analysis and briefings to senior military and civilian leadership up to the FO/GO level on emerging vulnerabilities and network defense actions
