- Establish clear and consistent priorities for JTF-GNO & NetOps requirements
- Develop and lead requirements processes, approval and configuration control boards for external capabilities development
- Based on J3 and other staff requirements, develop capabilities documentation, acquire resources and perform project management
- Provide continuity between operations concepts and capabilities development
- Develop and analyze measures of effectiveness for capabilities assessments
- Champion broad GIG NetOps (GEM, GND and GCM) capabilities
- Provide direct interface with key DISA / NSA capability developers
- Participate in DoD Enterprise Solutions Steering Group (ESSG) efforts
- Provide subject matter expertise in ESSG Technical Advisory Group reviews
- Represent JTF-GNO interests at GIG and DoD IA Portfolios (GIAP and DIAP)
